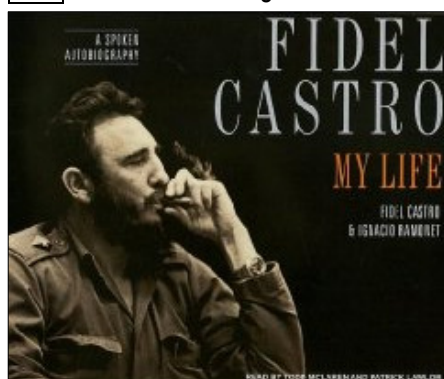

Fidel Castro & Ignacio Ramonet. **Fidel Castro: My Life**



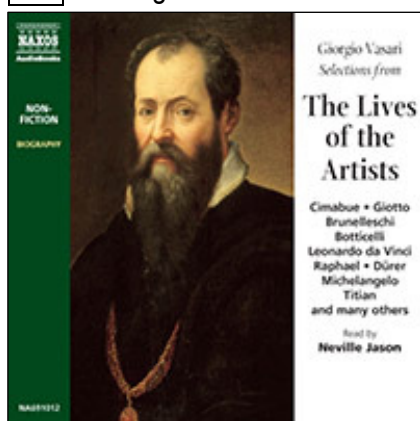
In February, 2002, Ramonet, the editor of French monthly *Le Monde diplomatique*, began a two-year conversation with the controversial Cuban head of state, a collaboration that resulted in this Q&A-style, Castro-approved look into the revolutionary leader's

life, from boyhood through his half-century in power. Ramonet proves a worthy interviewer, well prepared to tackle the famed Communist revolutionary's legacy, and while many of Castro's answers are predictably self-serving – "I've fought adamantly against any manifestation of the cult of personality" – the bombastic leader's views on political figures and world events are fascinating.

Giorgio Vasari. **The Lives of the Artists**



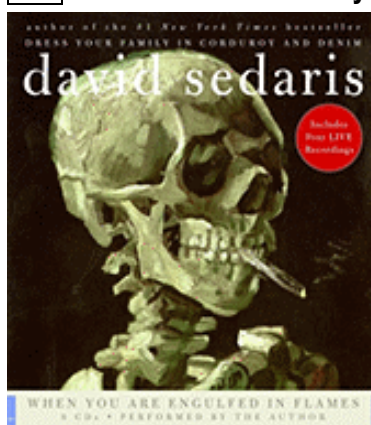
An Italian Mannerist architect and painter, Giorgio Vasari was acquainted with many of the most famous artists of his day. He is best-known today for his biographies of artists including Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, Michelangelo, Titian and Giotto.

The seismic explosion of artistic creativity that was taking place in Italy during the 15th and 16th centuries cried out for a chronicler – and who better to undertake the task than someone who was not just an historian, but an artist among other artists, situated in the eye of the storm, someone whose own gifts and training gave him the ability to recognise genius when he found it, and to distinguish the greater talents from the lesser.

David Sedaris. **When you are Engulfed in Flames**



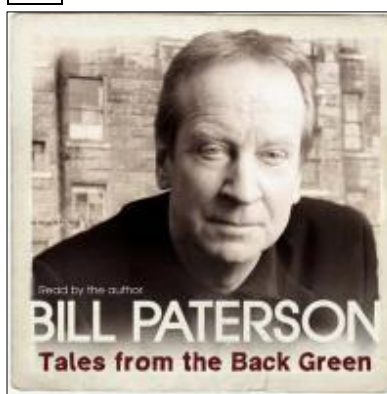
David Sedaris brings together a collection of essays both funny and profoundly moving that his legions of fans will fall for him once more. He tests the limits of love when Hugh lances a boil from his backside, and pushes the boundaries of laziness when, finding the water shut off in his house in Normandy, he looks to the water in a vase of fresh cut flowers to fill the coffee machine. From armouring the

windows with LP covers to protect the house from neurotic songbirds to the awkwardness of having a lozenge fall from your mouth into the lap of a sleeping fellow passenger on a plane, David Sedaris uses life's most bizarre moments to reach new heights in understanding love and fear, family and strangers.

Bill Paterson. **Tales from the Back Green**

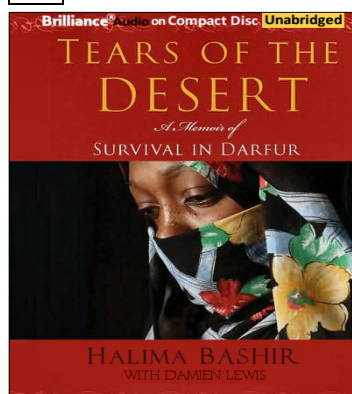

Always eager to push the boundaries of what they were allowed to do, Bill and his mates construct a giant dust atomic bomb, try to hold their own World Cup tournament and play endlessly on wasteland that's now unrecognisable from the exciting jungle of his childhood. *Tales From The Back Green* is not only a brilliant realisation of a time and a place, but a classic memoir of childhood that will strike a chord with everyone who's ever played and dreamed with little thought of life when I grow up.

Halima Bashir. **Tears of the Desert**



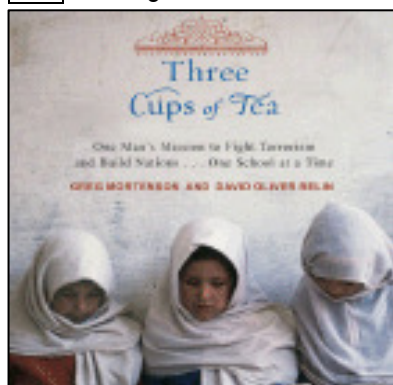
Born into the Zaghawa tribe in the Sudanese desert, Halima Bashir was doted on by her father, a cattle herder, and kept in line by her formidable grandmother. Halima excelled in her exams, and went on to become her village's first formal doctor. Yet not even the symbol of good luck that dotted her eye could protect her from the encroaching conflict that would consume her land. Janjaweed Arab militias

started savagely assaulting the Zaghawa, often with the backing of the Sudanese military. Then, in early 2004, the Janjaweed attacked Bashir's village and surrounding areas, raping forty-two schoolgirls and their teachers.

In this harrowing and heartbreaking account, Halima Bashir sheds light on the many thousands of innocent lives being eradicated by what is fast becoming one of the most terrifying genocides of the 21st century.

Greg Mortenson. **Three Cups of Tea**

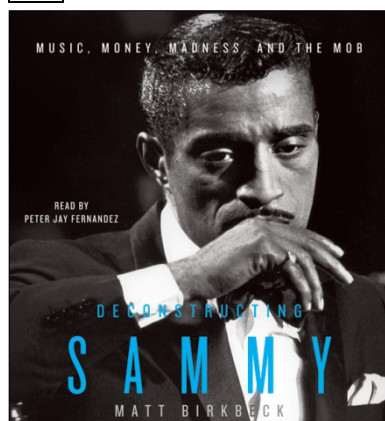

dangerous regions on earth. As it chronicles Mortenson's quest, which has brought him into conflict with both enraged Islamists and uncomprehending Americans, **Three Cups of Tea** combines adventure with a celebration of the humanitarian spirit.

Matt Birkbeck. **Deconstructing Sammy**



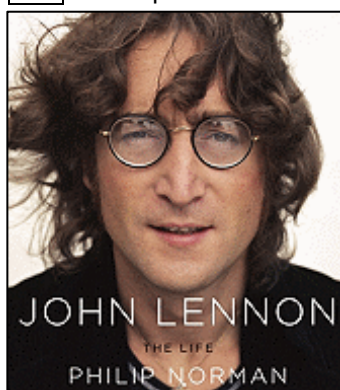

Philip Norman. **John Lennon: The Life**

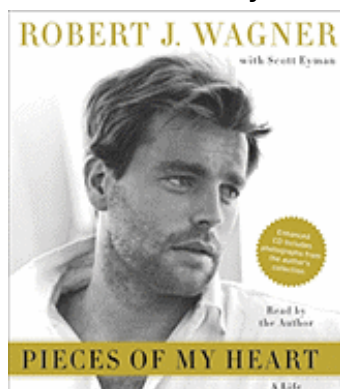

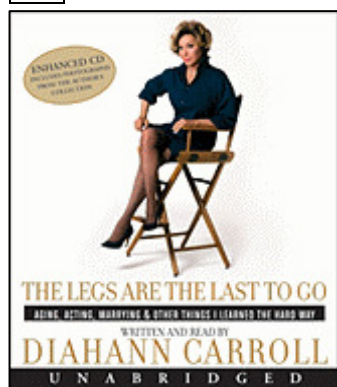
Cold Storage: In May 2003, an Arizona man who'd bought dozens of sealed boxes at an auction of unclaimed property made a horrifying discovery: the bodies of three plastic-wrapped infants. Police traced them to Dianne Odell, mother of eight children, who admitted the babies were hers but claimed that they'd died of natural causes.

Justice Deferred: In 1989, police had found the remains of a long-dead infant in a suitcase in the trunk of a car Odell had abandoned. The statute of limitations on manslaughter had saved her then from prosecution. She maintained that the foetus was the product of a rape by her father, and stillborn.

Baby-Killer's Fate: Odell said her domineering mother had forced her into teen prostitution and murdered what she viewed as "bastard children". Both parents were dead, unable to contradict her. Would Odell's stories sway the jury and buy her mercy?

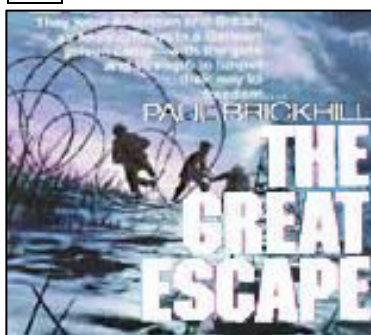

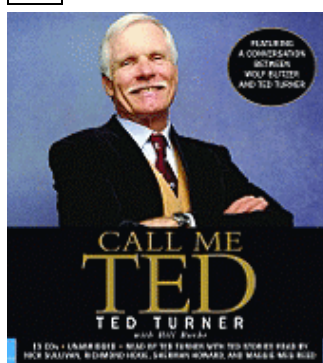

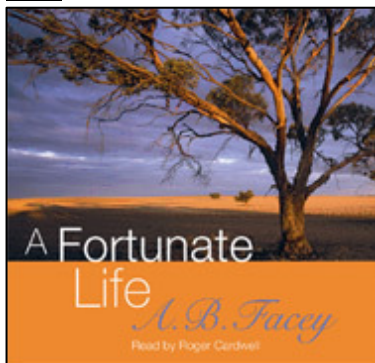

A. B. Facey. A Fortunate Life

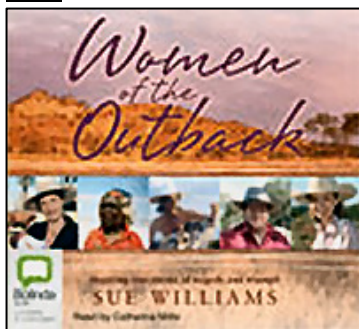

Emmanuel Jal. War Child



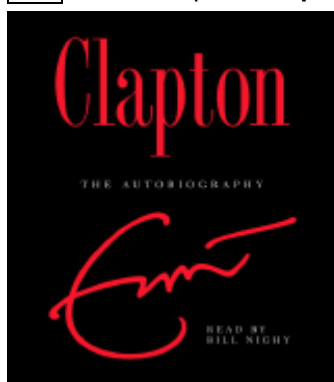
In the mid-1980s, Emmanuel Jal was a 7 year old Sudanese boy, living in a small village with his family. But as Sudan's civil war moved closer, with the Islamic government seizing tribal lands for water, oil, and other resources, Jal's family moved again and again, seeking peace. On one terrible day, Jal was separated from his mother, and later learned she had been killed; his father

Simon rose to become a powerful commander in the Christian Sudanese Liberation Army, fighting for the freedom of Sudan. Soon Jal was conscripted into that army, one of 10,000 child soldiers.

Jal survived a horrible decade, and his life began to change when he was adopted by a British aid worker. He began the journey that would lead him to change his name and to music: recording and releasing his own album, which produced the number one hip-hop single in Kenya, and from there went on to perform with Moby, Bono, Peter Gabriel, and other international music stars.

Eric Clapton. Clapton: The Autobiography



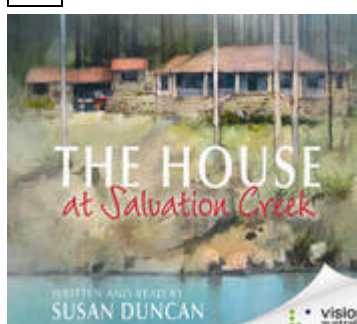
Born illegitimate in 1945 and raised by his grandparents, Eric Clapton never knew his father and, until the age of nine, believed his actual mother to be his sister. In his early teens his solace was the guitar, and his incredible talent would make him a cult hero in the clubs of Britain and inspire devoted fans to scrawl "Clapton is God" on the walls of London's Underground. With the formation of Cream, the world's first super-

group, he became a worldwide superstar, but conflicting personalities tore the band apart within two years.

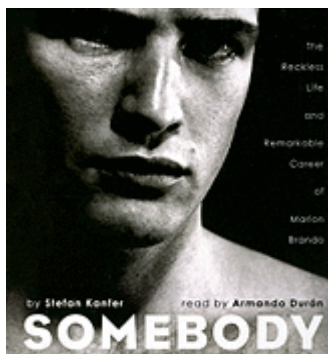

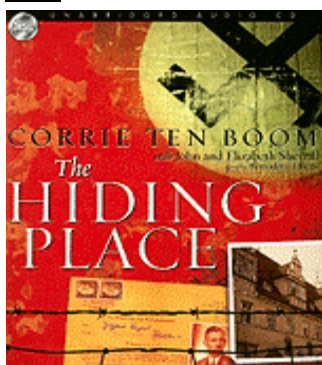

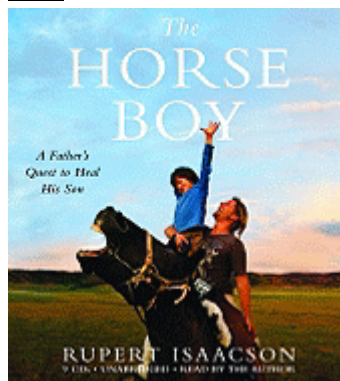

Rupert Isaacson. The Horse Boy

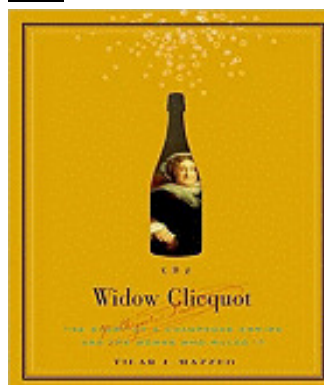

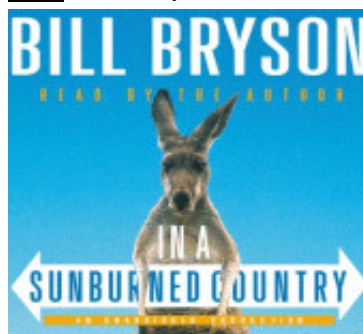

Bill Bryson. In a Sunburned Country

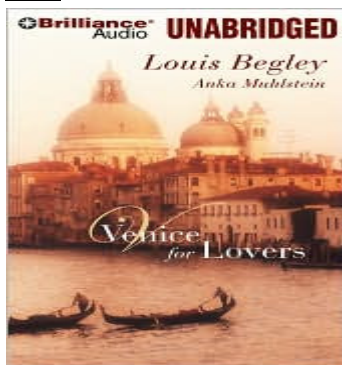

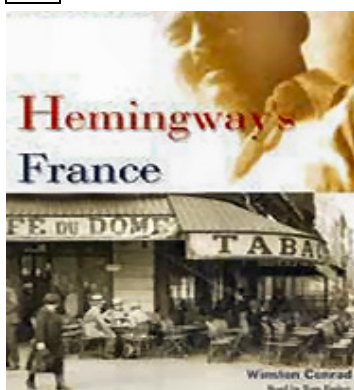

They meet Venetians like Ernesto, who tells them of the flood that nearly destroyed the beautiful city; and Nerone, an authoritarian chef who serves the freshest seafood and throws yesterday's catch to the cats. And they spend blissful hours at Da Fiore, named by the International Herald Tribune as one of the ten best restaurants in the world...
